Then on January 27 she was baptized in one of our services! At her baptism, her grandma and her good friend got saved. Her life and eternity have been changed forever because of you! That is fruit to your account.



As we look ahead to 2019, we are more focused than ever to continue creating churches unchurched people love to attend. We want to reach more people like Kayla and that is why we work so hard at growing our churches and meeting the needs in our community through MyCityCare. It will take all of us to make 2019 our best year yet!

I feel compelled to encourage you as the Apostle Paul encouraged the church members in Galatia. He said in Galatians 6:9, "Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up." I love you so much, and I'm also so very proud of you!





"Because of words I'd had spoken over me I've always had a low self esteem. And, even though I knew they were not intended to make me feel less of myself, they did. Then I listened to Pastor Kelly's Mind Craft series, specifically the one on your I AM statements and cried. I now knew who God said I was - and wrote out pages of I AM! I've never felt freer."

"It's amazing how applying what you learn on Sunday impacts your life throughout the week. During the Mind Craft series we learned about changing HOW we pray. Instead of my usual checklist of problem, I began praying and telling those mountains how big my God is. Within a week everything changed! The issues that had felt so big and had been dealing with were solved!"

"I've attended church before but always felt judged. Like I didn't belong. I didn't say the right things, didn't dress the right way and what was worse, suffered from some mental health issues that just made everything worse. Then I came to MyVictory. There are no labels, no groups you have to go stand beside because you are 'one of those,' just people who love God, and really believe in 'no perfect people allowed.' I've grown so much! I can now look people in the eye, and even have the confidence to walk up to complete strangers and have a conversation. And those health issues that controlled so much of my life? They don't control me as much as they once did - I'm being healed!"





People assume that community will just happen, but no matter the size of your church, it takes intentionality and hustle. Our Connect Groups are designed to build community. Every group, in every site is a franchise of each other. They are designed to go deeper into Sunday's Scriptures, in how to apply Sunday's message to our lives, to help grow disciples and most importantly, to build relationships. Relationships are the glue of the church and they are built in our Connect Groups. We have upwards of 600 people in connect groups across all sites. That is amazing!

Here are just a few comments from our groups:

"It's been an incredible journey leading the group, the friendship that I've made with each of them will last a life time..."

"We have GREAT conversations - I think it's one or our strengths as a group."

"We all feel connected and are making new friends in church."

Across all campuses, there have been numerous reports of baby showers in groups, arranging meals for families who have lost a loved one, moving vans rented to help families who are moving, not to mention the emotional and prayer support groups offer. 

Our favourite memory of the year was the My City Christmas experience Joining all the campuses and working in unity to bring a message of hope to so many people throughout the province.


















PASTOR MATT & CHARMAINE

Greetings MyVictory family!

We are excited to report that 2018 has been a year of continued growth for us as a church. We outgrew our previous location and in January, we moved into the Centennial Centre, the largest facility our community has to offer. We grew by 32% last year and continue to make more room in our facility to accommodate the growth.

We've had many testimonies come in since planting the church. We've seen broken relationships restored, physical healings like the story of Lukah Mitchell. Our church gathered around to support our friends and family as the Mitchell's went through extreme circumstances when their 11 month old daughter was airlifted to Edmonton. She needed a liver and full abdominal transplant. She was given 12 days to live. Through a miracle of God, the Lord preserved her life while she waited for a perfect donor. That donor came through on December 16th, our team cried with happiness as we got the news. The surgury was the first of it's kind in Western Canada and shocked physicians as they found a miracle inside of her. Her heart had created a ventricle that attached to liver as well as a capsule that had formed around the deteriorating organs to sustain her life up until the surgery. The surgery was a success! Her story is a testimony of God's healing power through faith and community

Our music team and kids program have been a huge draw and invite tool for our campus. Our campus has seen an increasing growth in young families. Our children's ministry has grown by 27% and has seen 44 Salvations in 2018!









On Remembrance Day, we partnered with the Royal Canadian Legion in putting on the local service. Pastor Matt officiated the ceremony, our kids team provided children's ministry and our host team served our veterans and volunteers with a private lounge. Over 3,000 people attended this community event. After the event, the Legion asked Pastor Matt to be their local Chaplin. He accepted and was set in on February 12.

My City Care continues to be a strong presence to in our community. It has been a great tool for reaching the unchurched and involving many of our local businesses.


The Christmas Eve Service was a huge success with the combined efforts of all four campuses. We reached over 500 people in our community and saw 26 people give their hearts to the Lord! It goes to show the impact of being ONE CHURCH in different locations!

Greetings from your church family in Lloydminster!

First of all, I want to say thank you. Thank you for your prayers, thank you for your friendship, and thank you especially to those of you who came to Lloydminster in December to help us run the MyCityChristmas project. What a gift it was to serve along so many of you as we together reached out in a significant way to our community!

This has been a challenging year. If you were to ask any of us in leadership here in Lloydminster, I think you would find that this year has not gone the way that we envisioned or hoped. Despite what things might look like from the outside, there is no sense among the leaders of our leaders or our congregation that this year has been a failure or that God is done with MyVictory Lloydminster.

We have many things that have happened this year that are worth celebrating and we are happy to take this opportunity to share some with you.

MyCityCare – Stuff the Bus: Stuff the Bus was an incredible success. We were able to hand out a large amount of backpacks and school supplies, sharing Jesus' love in practical ways to families in our community. The other great thing that we celebrate out of Stuff the Bus were the partnerships that we built with local businesses and schools who are all passionate about caring for the community in this way!

Connect Groups: Our Connect Groups continue to be the lifeblood of our church. One of the hallmarks of our church in Lloydminster is a sense of love and family that God has developed amongst us, and one of the key ways in which He has done this is through our Connect Groups. Whether it be with what we would call our regulars or people who have joined our church/groups for a season, one of the comments we regularly hear is that there is something special about the community that exists in our groups. People recognize the difference in our friendships and it's something they desire to experience and be part of.



Bible Reading: One of the commitments to growth that we made as a church this year was to read our Bibles every day. It's been awesome to see the buy-in across our church, indicating a desire to grow and encourage one another in this growth and discipline as well. We've recognized that the makeup of our church has included many young believers – "little children" (as we follow Pastor Kelly's table model from 1 John 2) and we have a need and desire to become "young men" – able to feed and sustain ourselves on the word of God. This has been a great encouragement to see people who previously struggled reading the Bible, reading it voraciously and finding God's goodness and insights for their day-to-day lives.

My sense of 2019 is that we as a campus need to take stock of where we are as a church so that we can move forward. We want to grow, we want to see people come to faith in Jesus, we want our neighbours, family's, co-worker's, and classmates to meet Jesus, and it's because of this desire that exists across our church that I have hope. If we had somehow lost this, we'd be in real trouble, but our commitment to our mission and vision is still very strong. Although as I said at the beginning of my report that this year has not gone the way we hoped or planned, we have faith and hope that Jesus – the author and perfector of our faith – will direct our path into something so much better than anything we can ask or imagine, in His time and for His glory.

We can't wait to see what God's going to do in 2019!








